

ADULT Permit List for DPS

1. DL 14 A (online) form or at DPS. You can search for this form online to print, fill out, and take it already filled in and signed to make your appointment go faster.
2. Texas Residency Affidavit Form (online) DL 5. You can search for this form online to print, fill out, and take it already filled in and signed to make your appointment go faster. Applicant signs Applicant and also Certifier line. If you are using another person's bills or statements to show where you live, that is fine but they need to sign the certifier line if their name is on the bills or docs. The two addresses must match. PUT THE ADDRESS YOU WANT ON THE PERMIT and the one you have proof of residency. There is a list on the back of the form with appropriate documents to prove residency. Physical address, no PO boxes and if bills or statements, do not use them if over 30 days old. Note: It is possible that even as an adult if you are using another person as a certifier you may need to have them go with you to DPS. Stop by the door ahead of your appointment and ask if this is needed if you are not sure.
3. A VOE (Verification of Enrollment) from the high school office if you are 18 and still in high school. Ask for this at least five days before you need it as some high schools have this as a requirement and do not give them in a one day turn around. If you have recently graduated high school or recently turned 18 you may want to take a report card or a copy of your diploma just in case.
4. ADE 1317 "DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE EXCLUSIVELY FOR ADULTS". You will receive this from your six-hour online class. It will be a white half sheet. Print it out. NOTE: If you are 25 or older, you may not need the six-hour class. If you are moving in from out of state or lost your DL in earlier years you may need to take the six-hour class even if 25 or older. You can usually go to the door at a DPS and ask them this question if you want confirmation on the need for the class. Online or a commercial school such as ours both give the ADE 1317 upon six-hour class completion.
5. \$33 fee. Cash, exact change for DPS. A credit or debit card.
6. Birth Certificate, NO COPIES. Be sure it has the raised seal on the document. It is possible DPS may accept a passport if you are out of the country, however I would stop by and ask this question at the door before you are at your appointment and have to leave it to get the right documents. Be sure you check at a DPS office before you are in line at an appointment if you have questions about green cards.
7. Social Security Card, NO COPIES. Social Security cards still take a long period of time to obtain so be sure you have it before you go to DPS.
